O'Boyle, Cowell, Blalock & Associates, Inc. (OCBA) provided site design and landscape architecture services for Knapp Forest Elementary School, Forest Hills Public Schools. The project involved the siting of a two-story building, parking, bus drop-off and playgrounds on a hilly, 14-acre parcel.

Sustainability was a key feature for the building and site. A large, terraced, segmental concrete retaining wall was used to minimize earthwork and disturbance to the site. Additionally, many other building and site features were designed in accordance with LEED requirements. The project is currently being considered by the U.S. Green Building Council for LEED recognition.

Kingscott served as the architects for the project.
