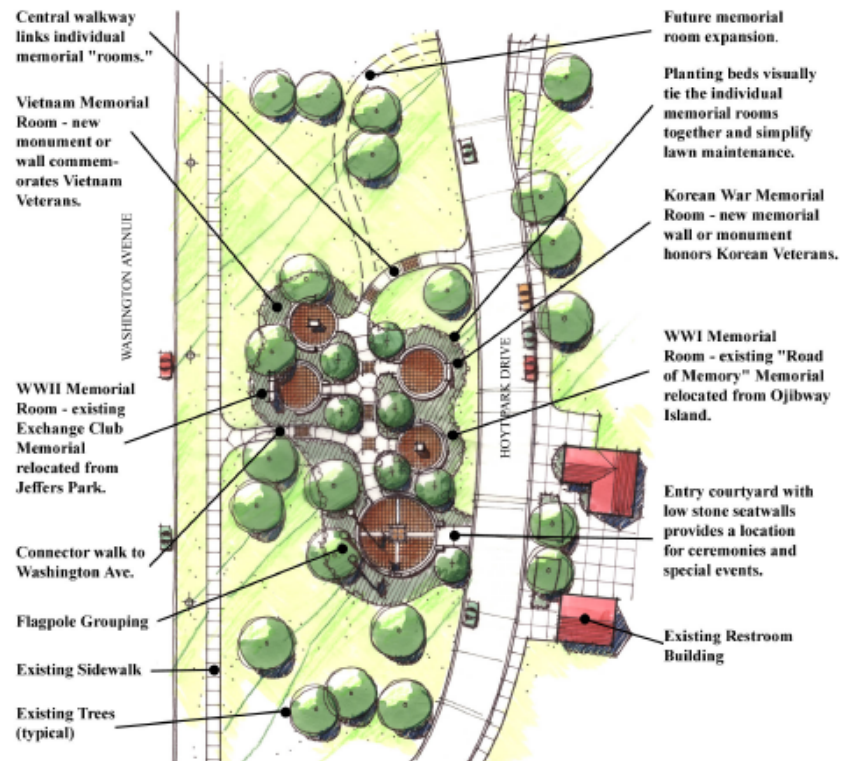


Saginaw County Veteran's Memorial Plaza

O'Boyle, Cowell, Blalock & Associates, Inc. (OCBA) was retained by the City of Saginaw to develop a plan and preliminary cost opinion for the proposed Saginaw County Veteran's Memorial Plaza. The plaza, sponsored by the Veteran's Council, utilizes two existing war memorials and two new memorials to honor area veterans. The plaza is organized into a series of "rooms" connected by a central walkway and landscaping. The memorial rooms provide private spaces for family and friends to remember those who were lost, while the entry courtyard creates a space for larger ceremonies and events.

The plan and preliminary cost opinion for site improvements includes the layout of monuments, hardscaped areas, walkways, site furnishings and landscaping. OCBA worked with a design committee assembled by the City to review design proposals.
